Carnivorous. Piscivorous, feeding mainly on small fish. Frozen and dry foods.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Streamlined predator adapted to ambushing its prey. Adult males very attractive with numerous colours. Despite its common name, this fish does not normally target the eyes of fish.

REPRODUCTION

Mouthbrooder: after spawning, the females incubate the eggs in their mouth until the fry are free-swimming. Males will mate with multiple females. The fry are easily raised with first foods such as baby brine shrimp.
