Difficulty:	Intermediate
Max Growth Size:	15 cm
Temperament:	Can be territorial.
Licensing:	Private Wildlife (Basic) Licence

HABITAT

Heating:	Provide a basking lamp heated to 30 - 36 degrees C
Lighting:	UVA / UVB (Exo Terra 10.0 globes recommended)
Environment:	Rocky outcrops. Provide plenty of hiding places.

Eyre Peninsula in South Australia.

FEEDING

Crickets and woodies dusted with vitamin supplement
