FEEDING

Mostly snails (commercial source or collected from an area where snail bait isn't used), worms, woodies, some tinned cat food.

The young of this species have blue tongues, which gradually change to pink as they reach maturity.

Temperament:	Docile. Will become tame with regular handling.
Licensing:	Private Wildlife (Basic) Licence

HABITAT

Heating:	23 - 26 degrees C with a basking spot heated to 29 degrees C
Lighting:	UVA / UVB (Exo Terra 10.0 globes recommended)
Environment:	Enclosure with a secure lid. Forest-style environment with some branches for climbing. This species requires high humidity, so regular spraying with water is recommended.
