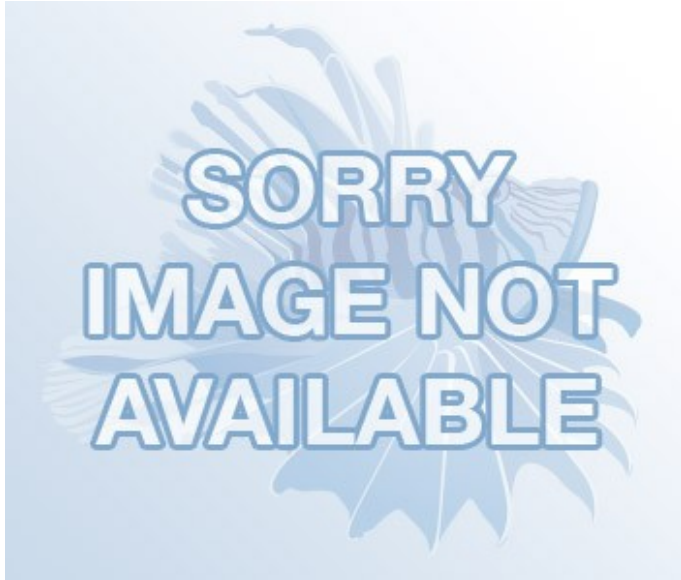




COMMON SCALY-FOOT
