




GIDGEE SKINK

Lighting:	UVA / UVB (Exo Terra 10.0 globes recommended)
Environment:	Shrub-land and open woodland. Provide rocks and branches. Critter Crumble recommended.

Semi-arid parts of Australia, and several
islands of the west coast of WA.
