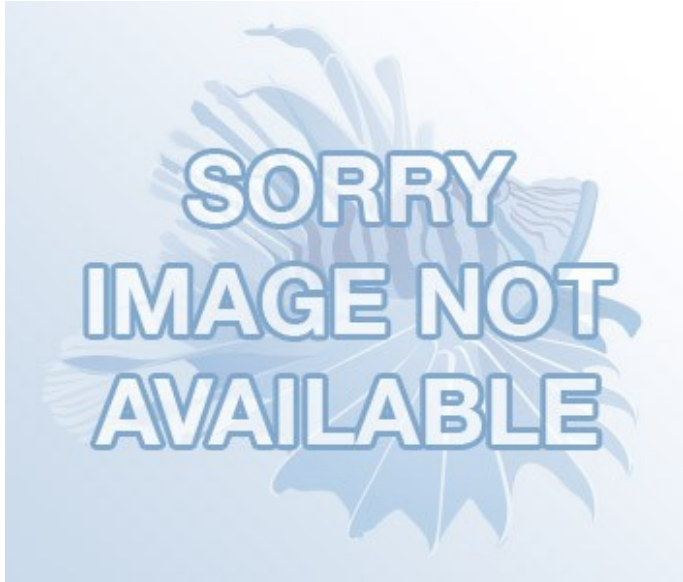

Temperament:	Can be thrashy, but with regular handling become tame.

Heating:	28 - 32 degrees C
Lighting:	UVA / UVB (Exo Terra 10.0 globes recommended)
Environment:	Desert sand substrate, rocky outcrop with branches. Tall enclosure and large water bowl or pond also required.
