<b>Difficulty:</b>	Intermediate
<b>Max Growth Size:</b>	1.2 metres
<b>Temperament:</b>	Can stress out quite easily, handle only when necessary.
<b>Licensing:</b>	Private Wildlife (Basic) Licence

### HABITAT

<b>Heating:</b>	47 - 50 degrees C
<b>Lighting:</b>	UVA / UVB (Exo Terra 10.0 globes recommended)
<b>Environment:</b>	Reptile sand, rocks and hiding places.

Australia wide

### FEEDING

Cockroaches, mealworms, pinkies - feed every 3-5 days.

### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

The Aboriginal word for the sand monitor is 'bungarra'.
