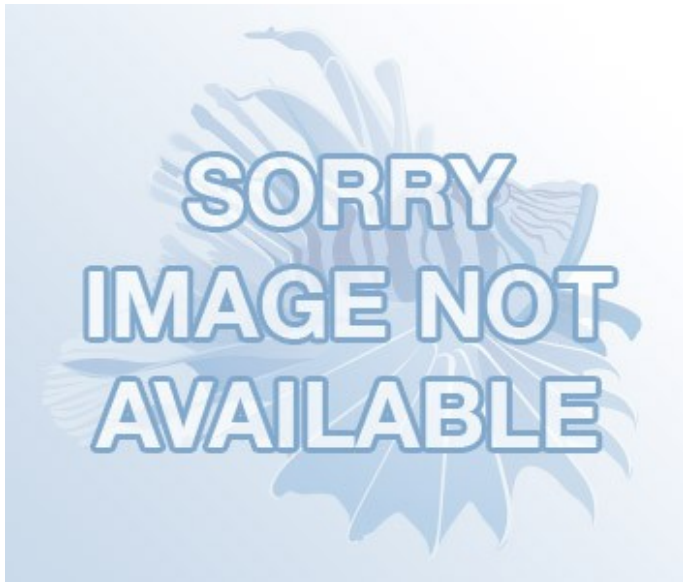




### SOUTHERN ANGLE-HEADED DRAGON
