Herbivorous and omnivorous. Frozen foods, but also dry foods with vegetable content.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Occurs at Taiwan reef, a remote area near the centre of the lake. Young fish and adult females are completely bright yellow-orange. Young males at first are also yellow, but as they mature they begin to darken, eventually turning dark blue-black with bright blue vertical bars. Ideal for a Rift Lake community tank with other small to medium sized species.
