ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Variable native gudgeon, with many subtle geographic colour variations. Hardy and easy to care for. Sometimes nip fins of tankmates, best kept in a good sized tank with similar sized or larger fish. An expert jumper, use a tight fitting lid.
