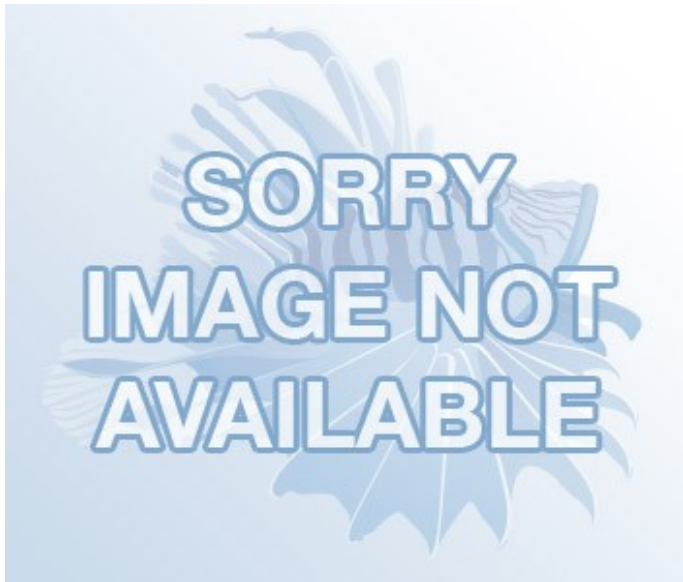




STH PURPLE SPOTTED GUDGEON - INVERELL

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

The Murray-Darling form of *Mogurnda adspersa* is considered endangered: wild populations are greatly reduced compared to historical distributions and are fully protected, it is already declared extinct in Victoria. Our Inverell fish are legally bred in captivity: they are suitable for either heated or unheated tanks (if temperature is at least 10 C.)
