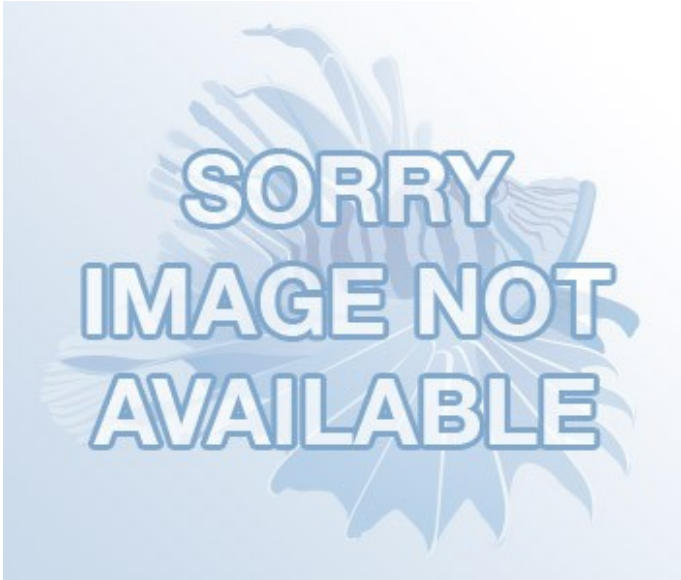




### RED STRIPED RAINBOW
