REPRODUCTION

A 'cuckoo' species, it lays its eggs during the spawning of mouthbrooding Cichlids, duping the female Cichlid into brooding the catfish's eggs as well.

FEEDING

Omnivorous. Eats most standard fish

foods.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Best kept in small groups. Provide some hiding places. Popular catfish for tanks containing Rift Lake Cichlids.
