



### THREAD FINNED ACARA (heckelii)

*Acarichthys heckelii*



Adult fish develop very nice long trailing filaments to their finnage and make excellent display specimens. Can be aggressive, so ensure tankmates are of a hardy nature. In nature this fish burrows into peat substrate and breeds in tunnels.
